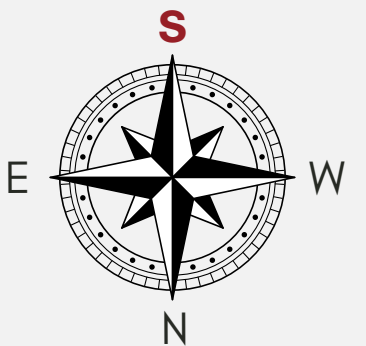

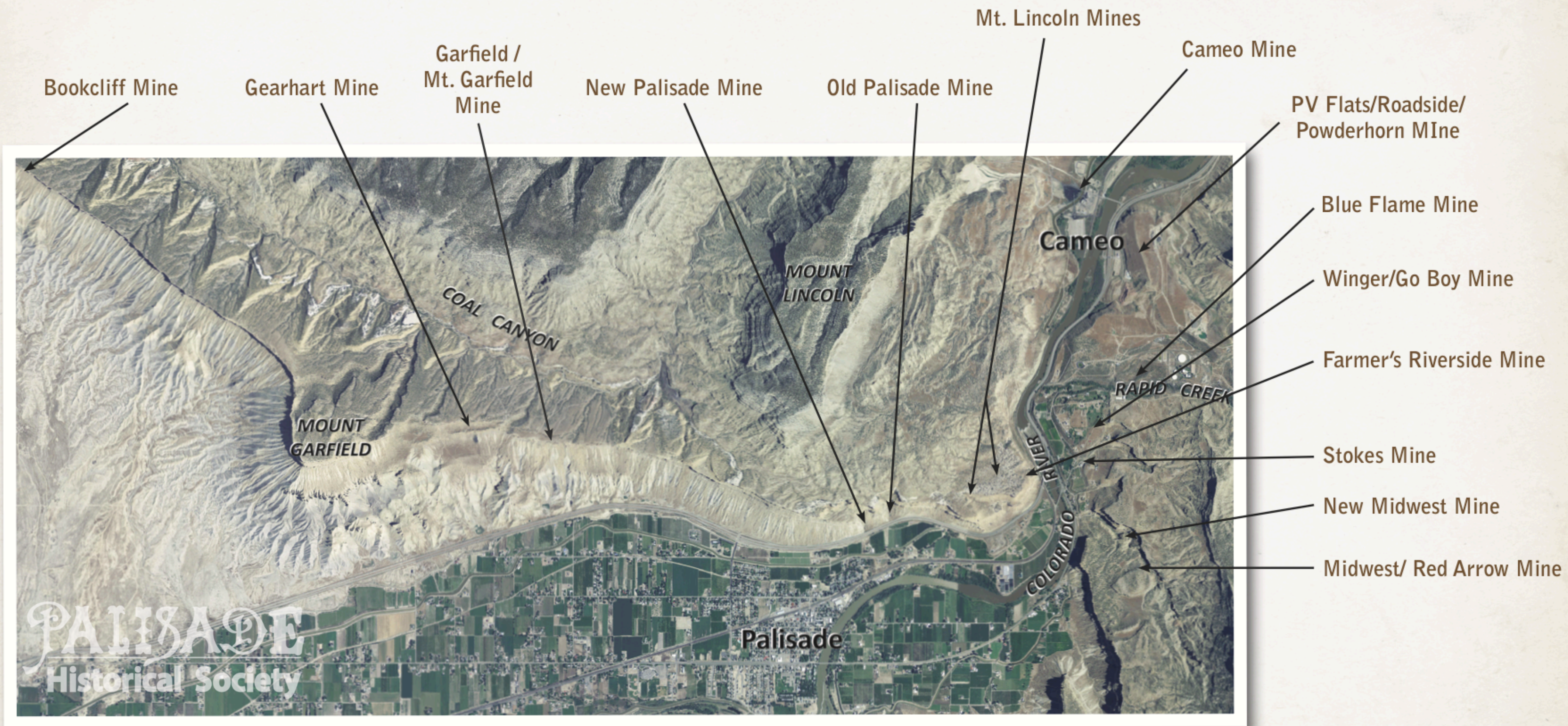

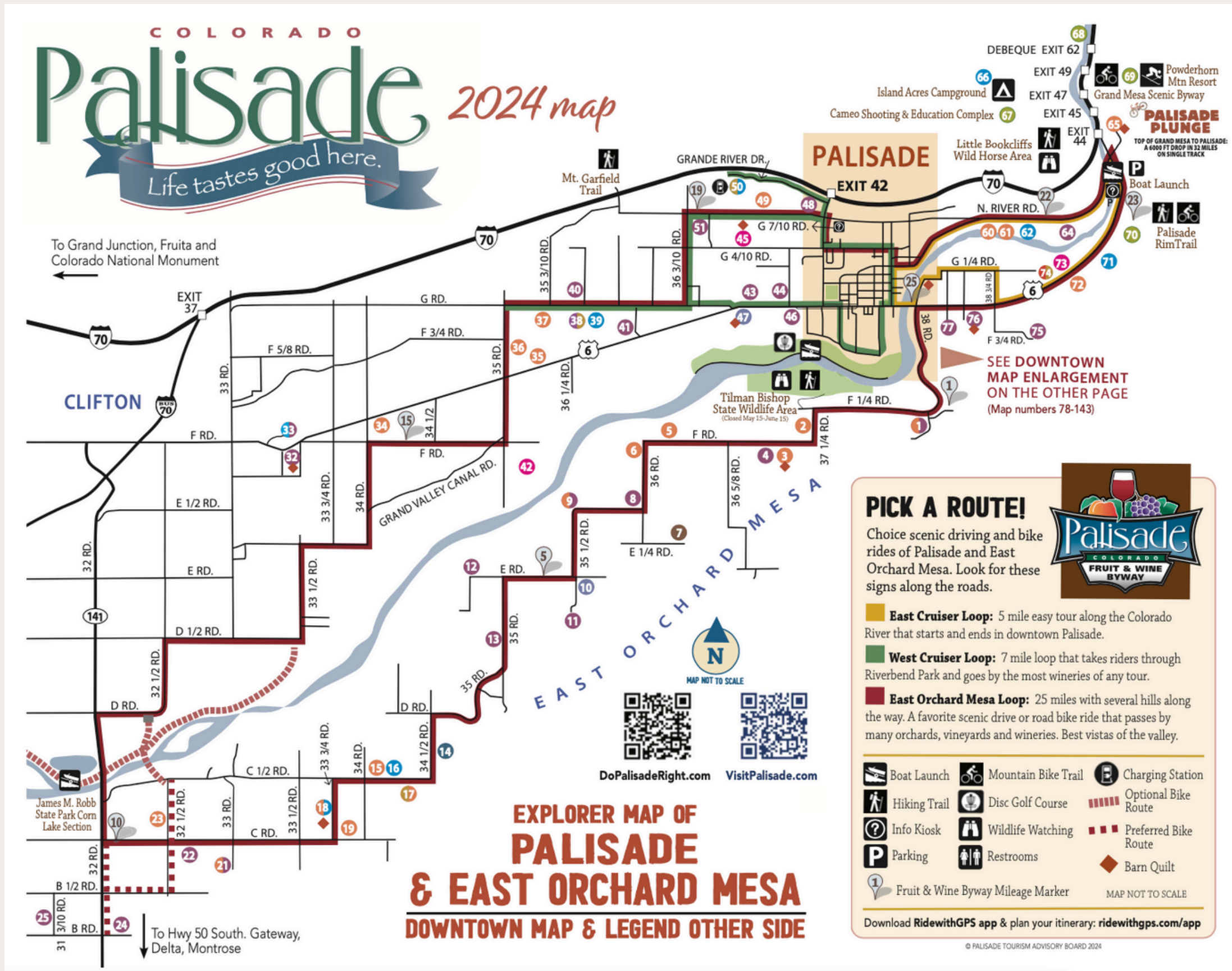
# DISPLAY HERE AT BASECAMP
